

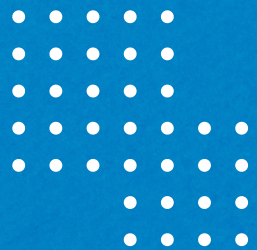

- Provide leadership, direction, recruiting, training, and oversight for all children's ministry (birth - 5th grade) teaching, events, budgets, volunteers, and safety that facilitate the fulfillment of the vision, mission, and values of FBC Murphy.
- Help develop and enhance a strategic milestone ministry that will equip parents to disciple their children through life stages.
- Collaboratively work with all staff and volunteers to accomplish the overall mission of FBC Murphy.
- Equip parents with creative strategies that help engage children during Sunday worship with the family, that facilitates continued faith conversations at home, building upon the experiences in corporate worship and Life Groups.
- Demonstrate a servant attitude and willingness to take initiative and assume any other responsibilities assigned by the pastor.

MURPHY DEMOGRAPHICS and CHURCH INFORMATION

FBC Murphy is located at 800 North Murphy Road in Murphy, Texas, next to McMillen High School (Plano School district) in a community of 21,013 with 72,626 people living within a 3-mile radius and over 217,128 people living within a 5-mile radius. Murphy is located in Collin County, one of the fastest-growing counties in Texas. The makeup of Murphy is 52% Caucasian, 26% Asian, 12% African-American, and 7% Hispanic. 96% of the households are married couples with children. These households have 5,373 children under the age of 18 living in Murphy, with 18,870 children under the age of 18 living within a 3-mile radius and 54,975 children under the age of 18 living within a 5-mile radius. Murphy has three K-5th elementary schools, one 6th-8th middle school, and one 9th-10th high school.

FBC Murphy is a gospel-centered family of many cultures and generations that exists to Magnify Christ, Multiply Disciples, and Mobilize Missionaries. Our values are God-centered Worship, Sufficient Scripture, Faithful Prayer, Authentic Relationships, Teaching Generations, Devoted Stewardship, Missional Living, Compassionate Outreach, and Strategic Missions. We affirm the Baptist Faith and Message 2000.

We average 100 people in Worship and 73 people in Life Groups. We currently have three different children's Life Groups on Sunday mornings and a Wednesday evening discipleship group for children called Blast. Our worship style is blended and contemporary. We partner with the city of Murphy to help with multiple community events throughout the year that occur off-campus, which focus primarily on reaching and serving children and families. We also have several other outreach events our church sponsors that also focus on reaching children and families. We have a \$310,000 budget for 2023. We are affiliated with the Collin Baptist Association, Southern Baptists of Texas Convention, and Texas Baptists.
